About FOI

The Freedom of Information Act 1982 (Cth) (FOI Act) gives a general right to the public and to staff to seek access to documents held by CSIRO.

Executive remuneration

The purpose of Subsection 72 of the PGPA Act is to help ensure transparency about government operations relating to companies by requiring meaningful information to be given to Parliament about those operations.

Gift and benefits register

Occasionally our Executive accept gifts and benefits in the course of their official duties.

Senate Order for Entity Contracts

In line with the Senate Order for Entity Contracts, CSIRO is required to publish twice a year on its website a list of all current contracts with a value of \$100,000 or more.

Harradine Report

In line with Senate requirements, CSIRO tables twice a year the indexed lists of files created in the Organisation's central office. Information about the requirement for Government agencies to place the file list on their website at half-yearly intervals and then table a letter in Parliament confirming this.

Public Interest Disclosure Scheme

The CSIRO PID Scheme is available to 'Public Officials' to make public interest disclosures.

Public interest certificates

A list of public interest certificates issued by CSIRO in accordance with s22 of the Government Procurement (Judicial Review) Act 2018 (Cth).
